ACCEPTANCE OF THE LOW BID FOR THE LANDFILL CAPPING CONSTRUCTION

WHEREAS, the Town Of Brighton through it’s professional consultant, Griffin International, solicited contractor bids for the closure of the former Town Of Brighton municipal landfill by a public notice published on October 16 and 17 in the Adirondack Daily Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, a bid opening was held on November 15, 2000 at 4:00 p.m. at the Brighton Town Hall in Paul Smiths, for the purpose of opening said bids, and

WHEREAS, the following eight sealed bids were received and opened:
